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Six Stages of Leadership

- Barbarian: (Stage -1) The lowest form of leadership forces resentful employees to obey based largely on threats.
- Benign: Stage Zero is a boss who manages schedules and inventory, but not people, based solely on title or position.
- Benevolent: (Stage 1) Friendly and kind.
 Employees don't mind obeying.
- Builder: Employees have respect for a teambuilder who gets things done and is clearly the right person for the job. (Stage 2)
- ◆ Believer: Stage 3 is a leader who believes in people enough to train and develop them to reach their potential.
- ◆ Born Leader: (Stage 4) Employees internalize the leader's passion and live it out whether the boss is present or not.
